<b>HB 1333</b> (Bell) <b>(Substitute)</b>	Sex Offender Registry; modifies registration of a person convicted of murdering a child

<b>HB 1347</b> (Bell) <b>(Substitute)</b>	Punishment for distributing, manufacturing, etc., drugs; penalty
