I. Bills Before the Subcommittee

HB 1604 (Putney) Parking Facilities Bond Act of 2009; created Authorizes the Treasury Board to issue revenue bonds pursuant to Article X, Section 9 (c) of the Constitution of Virginia in an amount up to \$16,000,000 plus financing costs to build a new parking deck in the City of Richmond at 7th and Franklin. Revenues derived from parking fund will be sufficient to cover debt service and operating expenses.

HB 1662 (Putney) Higher Educational Institutions Bond Act of 2009; created Authorizes the Treasury Board to issue bonds pursuant to Article X, Section 9 (c) of the Constitution of Virginia in an amount up to \$10,000,000 plus financing costs to renovate Ambler Johnston Hall at Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University. The bill states that an emergency exists and that the bill is effective upon passage. Residence hall revenues are sufficient to cover debt service and operating expenses.
