Consolidation Activities 2003 General Assembly

The Board of Education, in response to the Appropriation Act, convened a task force to develop a plan for consolidating services.

Consolidation Activities 2003 General Assembly

The plan included an examination of

- Academic programs
- Facility needs
- Transportation needs
- Arrangements for all students to continue receiving services

Consolidation Activities 2003 General Assembly

The Board of Education submitted a report entitled *Plan for*Consolidating Services for the Deaf and/or Blind and Multi-Disabled Students Served by Virginia's Two Schools at Staunton and Hampton, 2004.

Consolidation Activities 2004 General Assembly

Feasibility study conducted and submitted to the Governor and General Assembly.

Consolidation Activities 2005 General Assembly

The General Assembly authorized \$61.5 million for construction of a new school using Public-Private Education Act (PPEA).

Consolidation Activities 2005 General Assembly

Cost estimates for four different site options exceeded the \$61.5 million authorization.

General Assembly authorizes PPEA process for developing A&E drawings for the consolidated school.

Consolidation Activities 2006 General Assembly

The appropriation act also authorized a regional day program in Hampton Roads.

Pre-Design Due Diligence Activities

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Assessment of key buildings on Staunton campus

Eight buildings identified as "contributing" structures to Main Hall, a historic Staunton landmark

Pre-design Due Diligence Activities

Remaining Activities

- Continue schematic design
- Conduct second phase assessments of the buildings
- Refine cost estimates of the project schematic

Consolidation Activities 2007 General Assembly

The Board of Education and Department of General Services to enter into:

- 1. Conventional design contract, or
- 2. Interim agreement under the PPEA

Consolidation Activities 2007 General Assembly

FY08 funding of \$3.5 million to continue planning the Staunton campus and to facilitate the future use of the Hampton campus.

How will the \$3.5 million FY08 appropriation be spent?

- 1. Completion of the schematic design
- 2. Begin work on the preliminary design
