HB 1777 (Cosgrove)	Prohibition against concealment of dead body; penalty
HB 1794 (Griffith)	Penalty for object penetration
HB 1841 (Kilgore)	Penalty for statutory rape
HB 1856 (Wittman)	Deputies; shall be increased by Compensation Board
HB 1864 (Wittman)	Subsequent offenses of stalking; penalty
HB 1921 (Griffith)	Extortion by withholding immigration document
HB 1982 (Lohr)	Violation of provisions of protective orders; penalty
HB 2034 (Hamilton)	Payment for health care costs of prisoners
HB 2075 (Armstrong)	Assault and battery upon a law-enforcement officer to include ABC agents
HB 2176 (BaCote)	Virginia Disaster Response Fund; disbursements
HB 2185 (Miller)	Sex Offenses and Crimes Against Minors Act
HB 2200 (Wardrup)	State funds for local law enforcement; allocated for transportation
HB 2279 (Watts)	Child sex offenses
HB 2329 (Gilbert)	Mandatory minimum jail time for third offense DUI
HB 2332 (Gilbert)	Crimes; obstruction of justice; penalty
HB 2365 (Scott)	Larceny of a dog collar; penalty
HB 2429 (Albo)	Gangs and terrorism; penalty
HB 2459 (Cline)	Crimes against incapacitated adults; penalties
HB 2524 (Iaquinto)	Predicate criminal acts necessary for criminal gang member status
HB 2532 (Landes)	Unintentionally causing death of fetus punishable as involuntary manslaughter
HB 2571 (Shannon)	Sex offender registry; penalties

HB 2622 (Reid)	Harboring illegal alien; penalty
HB 2648 (Jones)	Producing abortion or miscarriage, etc.; penalty
HB 2749 (Hurt)	Sex offender registration; child pornography; penalties
HB 2828 (Peace)	Enhanced penalty for stalking of a minor under the age of 15
HB 2868 (McEachin)	Deputies; number of full-time appointed by sheriff of county
HB 2875 (McEachin)	Penalty for driving while intoxicated; subsequent offense; penalty
HB 2926 (Rust)	Immigration; powers of law-enforcement officers
HB 2960 (Bell)	Hotel or restaurant services, etc.; larceny; penalty
HB 2979 (Bell)	Use of communications systems to facilitate certain sex offenses involving children
