**I. Bills Before the Subcommittee**

<b>HB 245 (O'Bannon)</b>	Virginia Retirement System group insurance program; exemption from process
<b>HB 317 (Morgan)</b>	State employees; increases health insurance credits for those retired
<b>HB 369 (Carrico)</b>	Retirement System; state & local law-enforcement officers may take full retirement if have 25 yrs
<b>HB 411 (Griffith)</b>	Judges; member who is at least 50 yrs. of age, etc. to retire with full benefits
<b>HB 482 (Shuler)</b>	Higher educational institutions; optional retirement plan for certain employees
<b>HB 483 (Shuler)</b>	Higher educational institutions; retirement plan for teachers and administrative faculty
<b>HB 484 (Shuler)</b>	Retirement System; average final compensation retirement multiplier for teachers
<b>HB 695 (Armstrong)</b>	Retirement System; loss of retirement benefits for certain felonious convictions

<b>HB 736 (Caputo)</b>	Retirement System; average final compensation retirement multiplier for teachers
<b>HB 738 (Caputo)</b>	Retirement System; purchase of prior service credit
<b>HB 739 (Caputo)</b>	Retirement System; retired members to continue receiving retirement allowance
<b>HB 790 (Ingram)</b>	Retirement System; retired members to continue receiving retirement allowance
<b>HB 960 (Shannon)</b>	Retirement System; optional increase for local employees
<b>HB1211 (Melvin)</b>	Port Authority; establish a trust to offset other post employment benefits
<b>HB1212 (Melvin)</b>	Port Authority; encourages employees thereof to save for retirement
