HB 10 (Wright)	Line of Duty Act; coverage for fire company personnel of National Guard and Air National Guard
HB 78 (Abbit)	Health insurance; credits for certain retired public officers and employees
HB 112 (Byron)	Retirement System; early retirement provisions for certain local government officials
HB 128 (Purkey)	Retirement System; creating new defined contribution retirement plan
HB 271 (Miller, P.J.)	Line of Duty Act; amends definition of deceased person
HB 556 (Valentine)	Retirement System; investments related to Sudan
HB 846 (Sherwood)	State Police, Department of; variable housing allowance
HB 930 (Gilbert)	Retirement System; investments related to countries sponsoring terrorism
HB 981 (Nutter)	Retirement System; benefits for local law-enforcement officers
HB 998 (Bell)	Line of Duty Act; definition of disabled person to include local employees
HB 1148 (Phillips)	Local Government Manager Retention Program; retirement benefits for chief local executive employee
HB 1154 (Phillips)	Sick leave; retirement credit for unused balances of state & local employees
HB 1219 (Bowling)	Law Officers' Retirement System; supplemental allowance paid until Social Security retirement age
HB 1368 (Jones, S.C.)	Judges, substitute or retired; increases per diem compensation
HB 1436 (Bulova)	Line of Duty Act; funding for Line of Duty Health Benefits Trust Fund
HB 1460 (Moran)	Retirement System; investments related to countries sponsoring terrorism
