HB 149 (Fralin)	Independent living services & arrangements; require inclusion of plan for children 14 yrs. or older
HB 267 (Albo)	Involuntary commitment; enforcement of compliance with outpatient treatment
HB 365 (Carrico)	Substance abuse screening and assessment of public assistance applicants & recipients
HB 413 (Griffith)	Medical assistance services; increases amount disregarded from countable resources
