| <b>HB 1589</b> | <b>(Orrock)</b>         | Virginia Retirement System; duty of employers to correct erroneous records                          |
| <b>HB 1647</b> | <b>(Marshall, D.W.)</b> | Retirement benefits for City of Danville's sheriff  |
| <b>HB 1651</b> | <b>(Carrico)</b>        | Line of Duty Act; short-term disability benefits for state police officers                          |
| <b>HB 1684</b> | <b>(Valentine)</b>      | Retirement System; retirees may be hired as nurses without interrupting retirement benefits         |
| <b>HB 1742</b> | <b>(Pogge)</b>          | Deferred compensation plans, local; locality to provide automatic enrollment of all employees       |
| <b>HB 1818</b> | <b>(Kilgore)</b>        | Judges; increases mandatory retirement age from age 70 to age 75                                    |
| <b>HB 1827</b> | <b>(Fralin)</b>         | Retirement System; authority to manage and invest certain funds for postemployment benefits         |
| <b>HB 1858</b> | <b>(Shannon)</b>        | Retirement System; locality may increase retirement allowance for its employees                     |
| <b>HB 1911</b> | <b>(BaCote)</b>         | Teacher's retirement allowance  |
| <b>HB 1915</b> | <b>(Crockett-Stark)</b> | Line of Duty Act; exempts police department, etc., from requirement to reimburse investigation cost |

<b>HB 1949</b>	<b>(Shuler)</b>	Retirement system; teachers and administrative faculty of institutions of higher education
<b>HB 1960</b>	<b>(Mathieson)</b>	Line of Duty Act; continued health insurance coverage for disabled employee, etc.
<b>HB 1997</b>	<b>(Bulova)</b>	Line of Duty Act; includes local employees disabled on or after January 1, 1966 in definition
<b>HB 1998</b>	<b>(Vanderhye)</b>	Retirement System; removes cap on number of years of creditable service member may purchase.
<b>HB 2065</b>	<b>(Hamilton)</b>	Retirement System; provide benefits for regional jail's superintendent & sworn officers.
<b>HB 2068</b>	<b>(Tata)</b>	Retirement System; removes requirement that certain forms be notarized.
<b>HB 2069</b>	<b>(Tata)</b>	Retirement System; health insurance credits for retired teachers.
<b>HB 2128</b>	<b>(Cox)</b>	Retirement System; modifies several provisions governing benefits of members disabled or killed.
<b>HB 2139</b>	<b>(Miller, J.H.)</b>	Retirement System; retirees hired as school board security personnel without benefit interruption.
<b>HB 2143</b>	<b>(Nutter)</b>	Retirement System; purchase of prior service credit by teachers.
<b>HB 2146</b>	<b>(Nutter)</b>	Retirement System; adds school board members to membership.
<b>HB 2154</b>	<b>(Purkey)</b>	Retirement System; creates new defined contribution retirement plan for certain employees.
<b>HB 2280</b>	<b>(Bowling)</b>	Law Officers' Retirement System; supplemental allowance currently paid to certain members.
<b>HB 2357</b>	<b>(Gilbert)</b>	Virginia Retirement System; investments related to state sponsor of terrorism.
<b>HB 2457</b>	<b>(O'Bannon)</b>	Virginia Retirement System; investments related to Iran.
<b>HB 2574</b>	<b>(Miller, P.J.)</b>	Line of Duty Act; amends definition of deceased person thereunder, payment to beneficiaries.
