<b>HB 1727</b>	Cole	Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children; created, report.
<b>HB 1965</b>	Saxman	Public/Private Education Investment Tax Credit; created for business entities making contributions.
<b>HB 1985</b>	O'Bannon	Autism Tuition Assistance Grant Program; established
<b>HB 2018</b>	Rust	School Construction Revolving Fund; created.
<b>HB 2063</b>	Hamilton	Triennial census of school population; sales and use tax distribution.
<b>HB 2104</b>	Janis	Students with Disabilities Tuition Assistance Grant Program; created.
<b>HB 2335</b>	Amundson	Standards of Quality; state average teacher salary not be less than national average.
<b>HB 2474</b>	Hugo	Planning time for school teachers; school boards to ensure elementary school teachers are provided.
<b>HB 2654</b>	Rust	Public Education Distribution; Governor, etc. to develop plan to lower maximum Composite Index rate.
