**I. Bills Before the Subcommittee**

**HB 2464 Higher educational institutions, certain; management agreements with State (Morgan)**

Provides that the 2006 management agreements in place between the Commonwealth and Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, the College of William and Mary, and the University of Virginia will expire on June 30, 2012. Also makes adjustments to the policies governing capital projects, procurement, and financial operations and management.

**HB 2327 Community College Scholarship Match Program (Athey)**

Establishes the Community College Scholarship Match Program to provide matching funds to community college foundations and the Virginia Foundation for Community College Education. Funds may be paid on the basis of one dollar of state general fund appropriation for every one dollar donated by private individuals, foundations, or corporations beginning on July 1, 2009. These funds shall be used to award scholarships to students who (i) are domiciled residents of Virginia, and (ii) are enrolled in a Virginia community college.

**HB 1612 Community College Scholarship Match Program (Dance)**

Establishes the Community College Scholarship Match Program to provide matching funds to community college foundations and the Virginia Foundation for Community College Education. Funds may be paid on the basis of one dollar of state general fund appropriation for every one dollar donated by private individuals, foundations, or corporations beginning on July 1, 2009. These funds must be used to award scholarships to students who (i) are domiciled residents of Virginia, (ii) graduated from a public or private Virginia high school, and (iii) are enrolled in a Virginia community college. The provisions of the bill are contingent upon an appropriation of general funds in the appropriation act by the 2009 Regular Session of the General Assembly.

**HB 2295 Two-Year College Transfer Grant (Caputo)**

Increases the annual amount of the grant from \$1,000 to \$1,500.
