| <b>HB 1516</b> (Orrock)         | Assault and battery; if person commits against ABC agent, guilty of Class 6 felony.                  |
| <b>HB 1579</b> (Dance)          | Sex offender registry; penalties when registrants do not disclose all real property owned in State   |
| <b>HB 1628</b> (Watts)          | Sex Offender and Crimes Against Minors Registry Act; makes procedural changes                        |
| <b>HB 1762</b> (Crockett-Stark) | Schedule I; adds 5-methoxy-N,N-dimethyltryptamine to list  |
| <b>HB 1771</b> (Shuler)         | Law-enforcement deputies; allocation to city sheriff in certain cities without a police force        |
| <b>HB 1777</b> (Gilbert)        | Fake birth certificate; one who manufactures, etc., to establish false identity is guilty of felony. |
| <b>HB 1898</b> (Hugo)           | Abduction of minors; expands definition to include commercial sexual activity involving minors.      |
| <b>HB 2066</b> (Bell, R.P.)     | Sex offenders; prohibiting entry onto school grounds or other property, penalty.                     |
