### I. Bills Before the Subcommittee

<b>HB 49</b> (Albo)	DUI; raised penalty for aggravated involuntaty manslaughter
HB 87 (Knight)	Aircrafts; penalty for projecting laser towards
<b>HB 125</b> (Kilgore)	Uniform Power of Attorney Act; liabilty of agent, penalty
HB 287 (Iaquinto)	Gang-free zones; expansion of zone areas
HB 361 (McClellan)	Stalking; enhanced penalties
HB 363 (McClellan)	Protective orders; animals.
HB 508 (Garrett)	Cannabinoids, synthetic; amends provisions regarding criminalization
HB 546 (Comstock)	Gang crimes; includes definition of predicate criminal act
HB 596 (Crockett-Stark)	Methampetamine laboratory; in same place as child, etc. is guilty of a felony
<b>HB 624</b> (Albo)	Sex offender registry; juvenile registration
<b>HB 718</b> (Kilgore)	Juveniles; trial as adults
<b>HB 749</b> (Cline)	Assault and battery; adds campus police officers to list for enhanced punishment
<b>HB 751</b> (Cline)	Criminal street gang; recruitment of persons by telephone or electronic communication, penalty
<b>HB 752</b> (Cline)	Assault and battery against a family or household member by strangulation; penalty
<b>HB 771</b> (Landes)	Campus police officers; included in definition of law-enforcement officers
<b>HB 858</b> (Yost)	Tramadol; added to list of Schedule IV controlled substances
HB 953 (Bell, Robert)	Assault and battery; adds prison contractor to class of people victimized in prisons, penalty
HB 957 (Bell, Robert)	Zero tolerance; shall continue for two years following restoration of driving privileges for DUI
HB 962 (Bell, Robert)	DUI; penalty for maiming shall include a mandatory minimum term

confinement of one year

HB 963 (Bell, Robert)	Child pornography; solicitation by use of Internet, any electronic
	communication, etc., penalty
<b>HB 964</b> (Bell, Robert)	Grooming video; displaying to a minor, penalty
HB 967 (Bell, Robert)	Campus police officers; included in definition of law-enforcement officers
<b>HB 968</b> (Bell, Robert)	Drug trafficking; penalty for subsequent offenses
HB 973 (Bell, Robert)	Sex crimes; penalties
<b>HB 984</b> (Scott, J.M.)	Department of State Police; establishment of cold case searchable database
HB 987 (Loupassi)	Financial exploitation of elderly or incapacitated adults; penalty
<b>HB 1012</b> (Ramadan)	Criminal history record information check; elimination of fees
<b>HB 1074</b> (Hugo)	Prostitution; Class 1 misdemeanor for soliciation from a minor
<b>HB 1103</b> (Miller)	Criminal history record informatino check; making false statements, penalty
HB 1126 (Bell, Robert)	Sanctions with Unified Rapid Enforcement (SURE); created
<b>HB 1121</b> (Cox, M . K.)	Veterans Services, Department of; ratio of claims agents to number of veterans in State
<b>HB 1140</b> (Hodges)	Carisoprodol; added to list of Schedule IV controlled substances
<b>HB 1141</b> (Hodges)	Ezogabine; added to list of Schedule V controlled substances
