I. Bills Before the Subcommittee

HB 1379 (Yost)	Law-Enforcement Assistance Program; DCJS to develop a peer-counseling program
HB 1414 (Crockett-Stark)	Local jails; compensation for cost of incarceration
HB 1559 (Morris)	DUI; any person convicted of fourth or subsequent offense is guilty of Class 6 felony
HB 1606 (Hugo)	Prostitution; solicitation of a minor, penalty
HB 1682 (Bell, R. B.)	Mentally incapacitated persons; financial exploitation, penalty
HB 1684 (Bell, R. B.)	Identity theft; penalties
HB 1745 (Gilbert)	Children; use of communications system to propose sex offenses
HB 1746 (Gilbert)	Sentencing guidelines; definition of violent felony
HB 1751 (Miller)	Assault and battery; includes certain employees of DBHDS, penalty
HB 1783 (Gilbert)	Contraband cigarettes; increases penalty for possession with intent to distribute

HB 1816 (Kilgore)	Methamphetamine manufactory; penalty for allowing child or incapacitated person to be present
HB 1819 (Ware, O.)	DCJS; criminal justice training schools
HB 1820 (Ware, O.)	Unstamped cigarettes; sale, transport, possession, etc., penalties
HB 1847 (Albo)	Criminal street gang predicate offenses; expands class to include all felony crimes
HB 1850 (Albo)	Assault and battery; adds employees of local or regional corrections facilities
HB 1862 (Sherwood)	Sex Offender and Crimes Against Minors Registry Act; add to list of offenses requiring registration
HB 1927 (Morris)	Assault and battery; adds emergency medical services personnel, penalty
HB 1941 (Garrett)	Cannabinoids, research chemicals, synthetic; penalties
HB 1955 (Landes)	Impersonating a law-enforcement officer or other public safety personnel; impersonating, penalty
HB 2065 (Peace)	Juvenile correctional centers; penalties
HB 2211 (McClellan)	Stalking; penalty for conviction of second offense
HB 2235 (Lingamfelter)	Firearms; increases penalties for use, display, or discharge during commission of certain felonies
HB 2244 (Spruill)	School Resource Officer Grants Program and Fund
HB 2269 (Bell, R. B.)	Mandatory minimum sentences; term of confinement shall be served consecutively
HB 1730 (Cole)	Standards of Quality; full-time uniformed school resource officer
