
National Organization With Proven Record

 Communities In Schools Is In 51 Schools Across Virginia Serving 26,000 At-Risk Students

- With Recent Virginia Funding, Communities In Schools Is
 - ≻In 4 New Regions
 - ➤In An Additional 10 Schools
 - Serving 3,000 New At-Risk Students



Tracked Student Outcomes 2013-2014

Virginia

- 89% of Seniors Graduated
- 38% of Graduates Went to Some Form of Post-Secondary Education
- 84% of Tracked Students Were Promoted
- 79% of Tracked Students Were Promoted
- 78% of Tracked Students Improved Behavior
- 79% of Tracked Students Improved Attendance
