chesapeake bay wip iii – key investments

- \$10,000,000 for oyster restoration
- \$50,000,000 for the Stormwater Local Assistance Fund
- \$50,000,000 for nutrient removal technologies at municipal wastewater treatment facilities in the Chesapeake Bay watershed
- \$25,000,000 for Alexandria's Combined Sewer Overflow System

chesapeake bay wip iii – support for farmers

- \$35,000,000 to the Virginia Natural Resources Commitment for cost share assistance to implement best management practices
- \$4,550,000 for local Soil and Water Conserva Dixtricts to provide farmers with technical assistance
- \$1,000,000 to to poultry litter transport, nutrient management plans, and resource management plans

chesapeake bay wip iii – support for farmers

- \$250,000for DCR and Virginia State Iniversity Small Farm Outreach Program
- \$500,000for the Commonwealth's match for participation in the ConservatiorReserve Enhancement Program (CREP)
- \$250,000for VDOF's grants fortimber operation water quality best management practices
- \$250,000 for DCRdevelopment and continued maintenance of the Conservation Applicatio Suite

chesapeake bay wip iii — urban and innovative bmps

- \$500,000 for the Virginia Association of Soil and Water Conservation Districts Virginia Conservation Assistance ProgramVCAP)
- \$1,000,000for DEQClean Water Financing and Assistance Program "pay for documented performance" pilotrogram
- \$500,000for VDOF's Virginia Trees for Clean Waterrogram
- \$100,000 toVDH to document, map, assess and prioritize failing/failed onsite and community septic systems
