



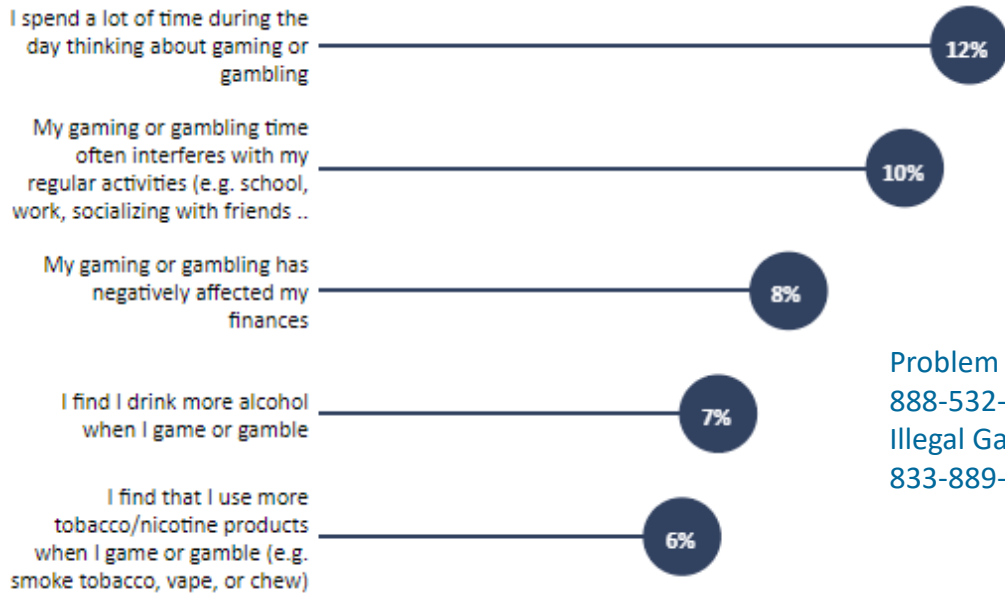

Problem Gambling Treatment & Support

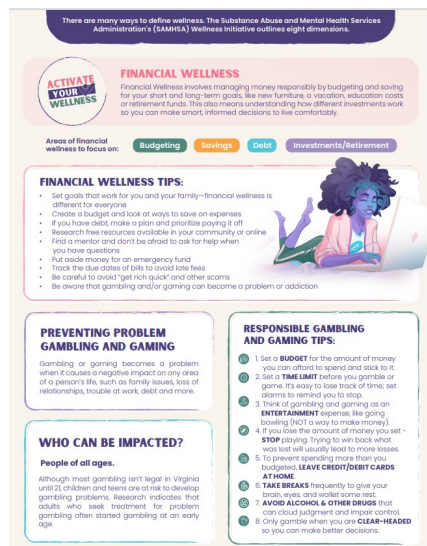

Problem Gambling Treatment and Support Fund – Putting it to Good Use



Prevention – Services

- Assessment – behavior, knowledge, capacity, environment
- Capacity Building
- Planning
- Implementation
 - Education (youth, merchants, general public)
 - Information Dissemination (what it is, signs, helpline, etc)
 - Policy Change (skill games 21+, school events non-gambling, etc.)

Treatment - Clinicians

- Certified and trained 6 in 2021 to 81 in 2023
- 527 screened; 332 referred
- Paid for 297 assessments/tx

Recovery – Peer Services

- 0 in 2021 to 17 in 2023
- 228 referred
- Paid for over 181 peer services
