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# What is School Readiness?

- Skills children have when they enter school that prepare them for later school success

*Language, Self-regulation, Social skills,  
Literacy, Mathematics, Science,  
Motor skills, Health*



# What Does Readiness Look Like?

## *Example Indicators*

### **Literacy**

- ✓ Identifies parts of a book
- ✓ Identifies most letters
- ✓ Knows the sounds associated with *some* letters
- ✓ Understands that words are made of letters

### **Math**

- ✓ Uses one-to-one correspondence when counting
- ✓ Knows that the last number counted is the number of objects in a set
- ✓ Replicates simple patterns

### **Science**

- ✓ Makes predictions

### **Motor Skills**

- ✓ Has body awareness
- ✓ Can adjust grip to use different tools

### **Self Regulation**

- ✓ Controls behavior when faced with challenge
- ✓ Focuses attention for 15 minutes or more

### **Social Skills**

- ✓ Seeks help from teachers when needed
- ✓ Shares & compromises with peers

# How to Use Kindergarten Readiness Data

Using data-driven tools to understand the degree to which children start kindergarten “ready”

- Data used to look forward and backward
  - Inform both early childhood and early elementary education practices
- Provide actionable data to division leaders, principals, teachers, policy makers & other stakeholders
  - Identify sites or populations that need intervention to ensure students’ school success
  - Provide a benchmark – over time used to determine if the school, division, region and/or state has made progress in improving child outcomes

# Virginia Kindergarten Readiness Program (VKRP)-History

## **Phase 1: 2013-14– Selecting the right tools**

- Literacy - Teacher standardized administration (PALS)
- Math - Teacher standardized administration
- Self-regulation - Teacher report via rating scale
- Social-skills - Teacher report via rating scale

**Phase 2: 2014-15—Piloting measures and determining statewide representative sample of readiness**

**Phase 3: 2015-17—Statewide voluntary roll out**

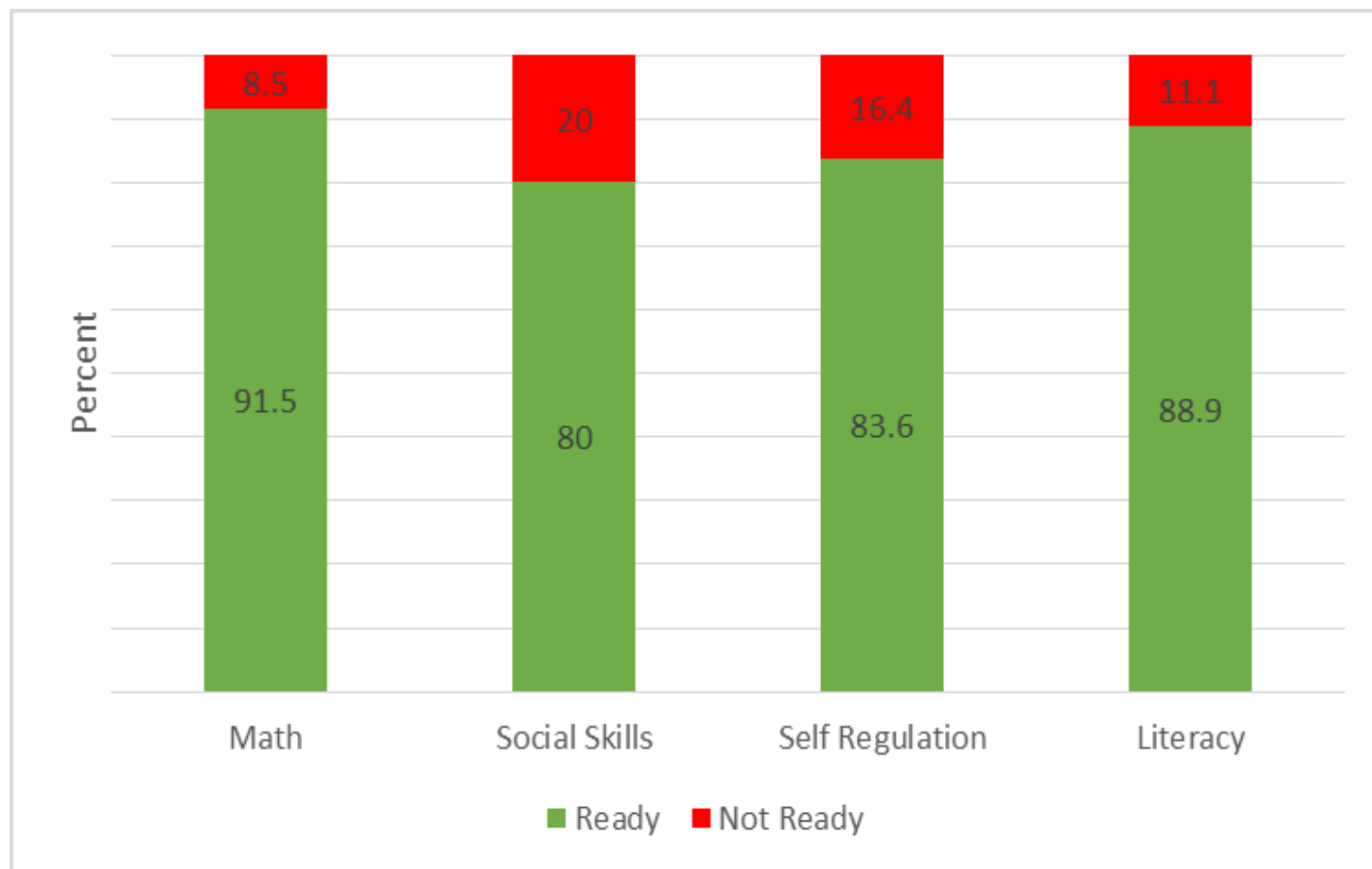

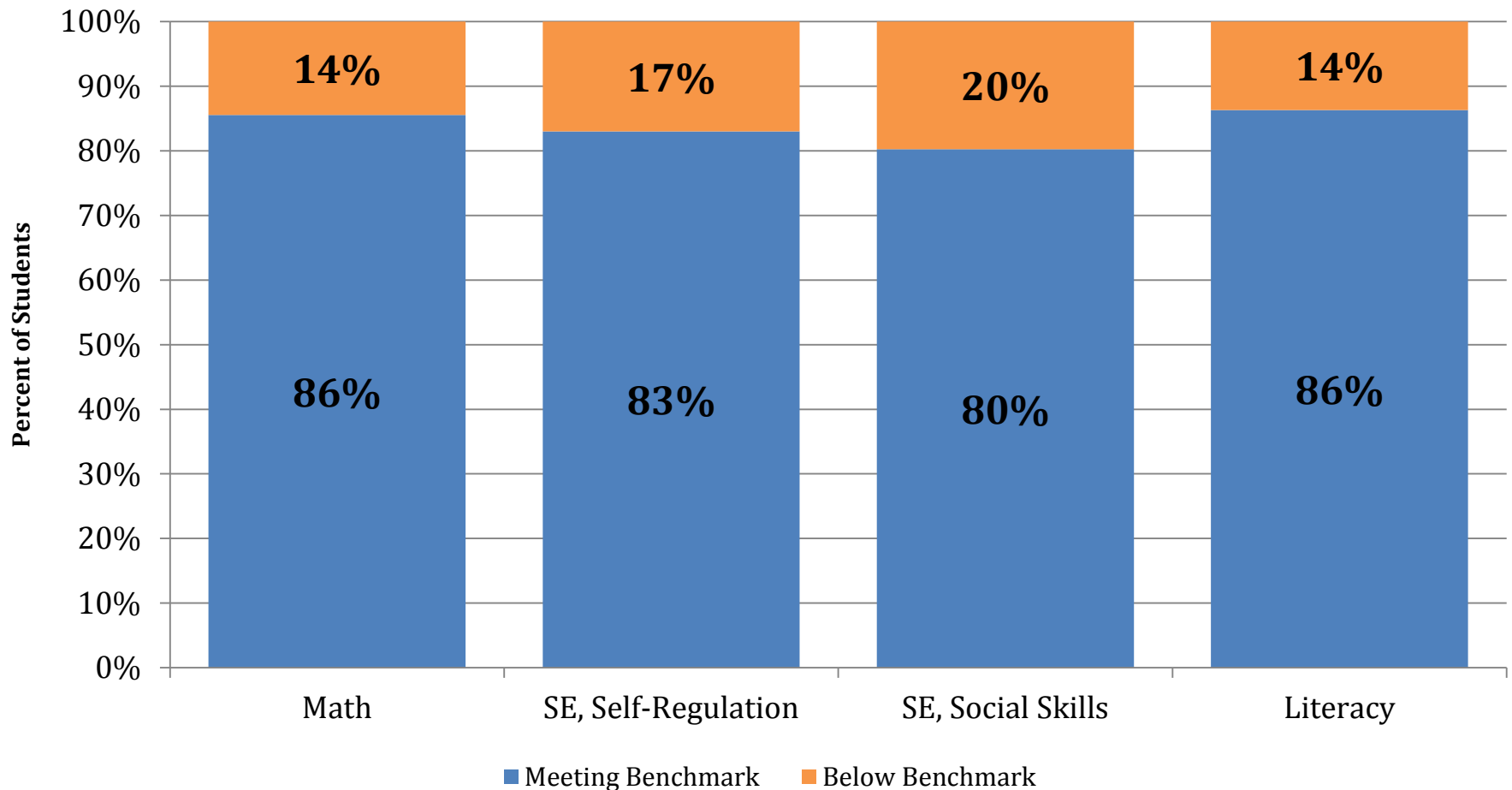

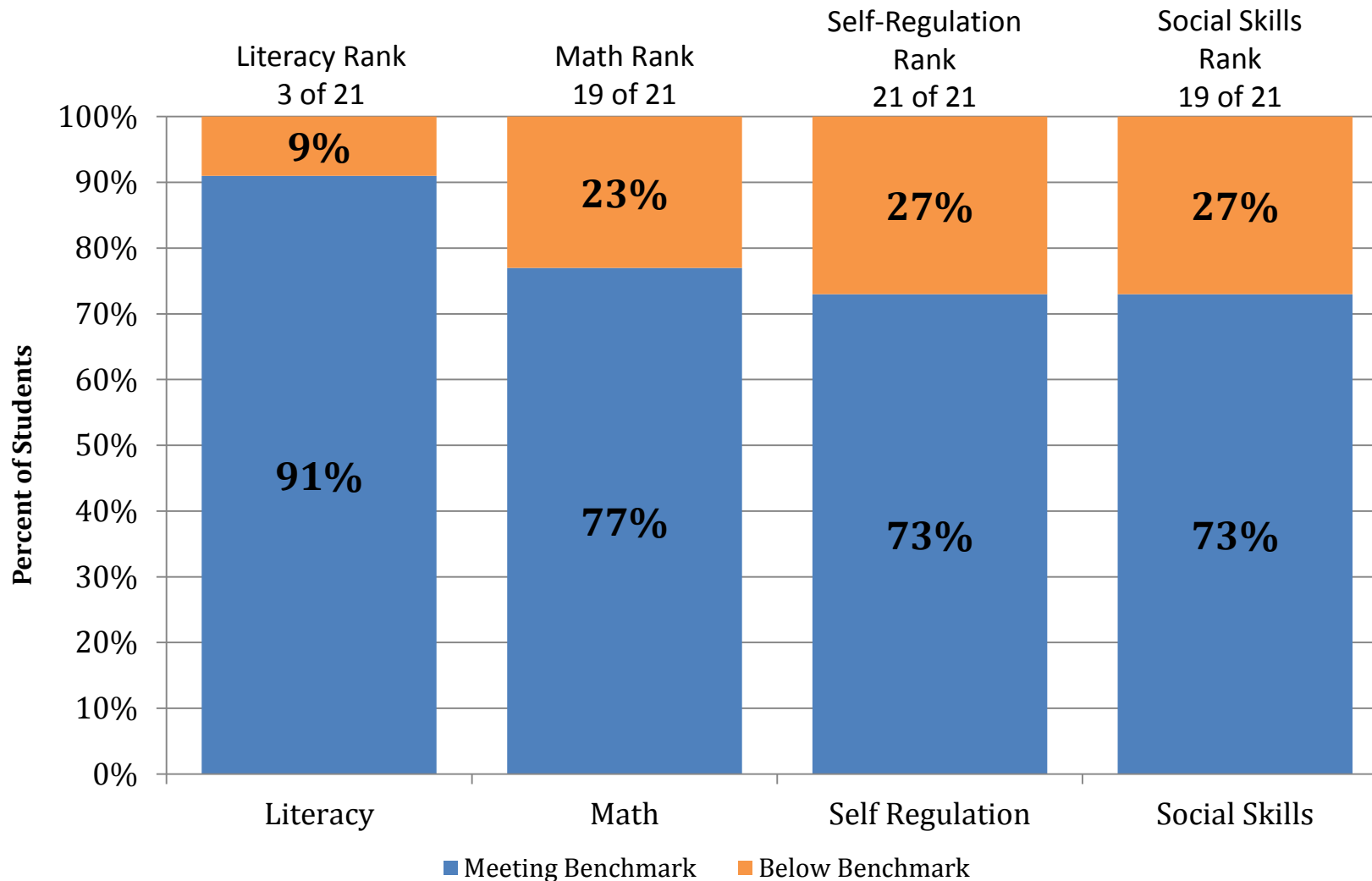
## Percent of Students “Ready” or “Not Ready” by Domain

Fall 2015



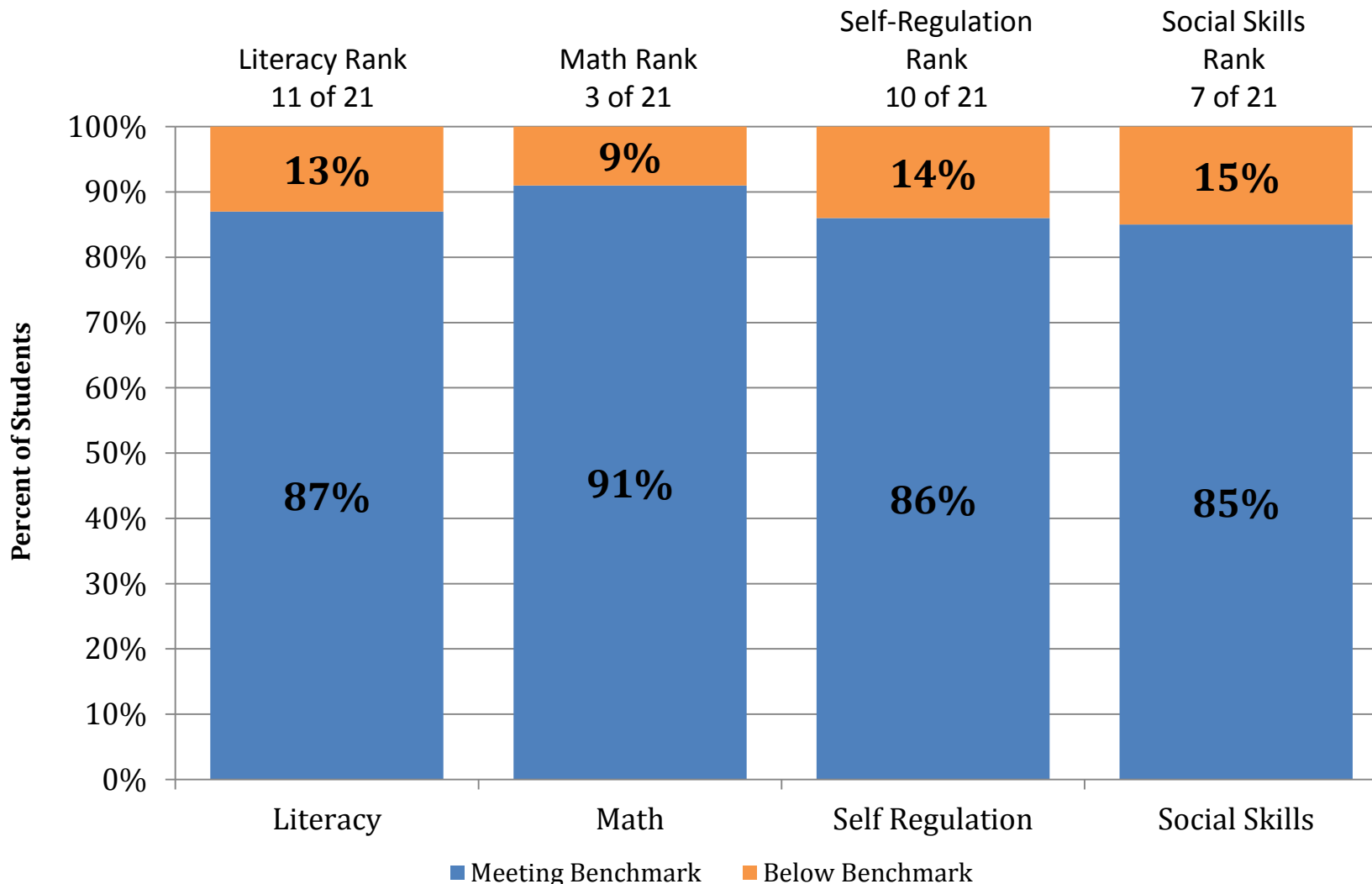
# Readiness Variability-Example Division 1

## Division "N", Fall 2015

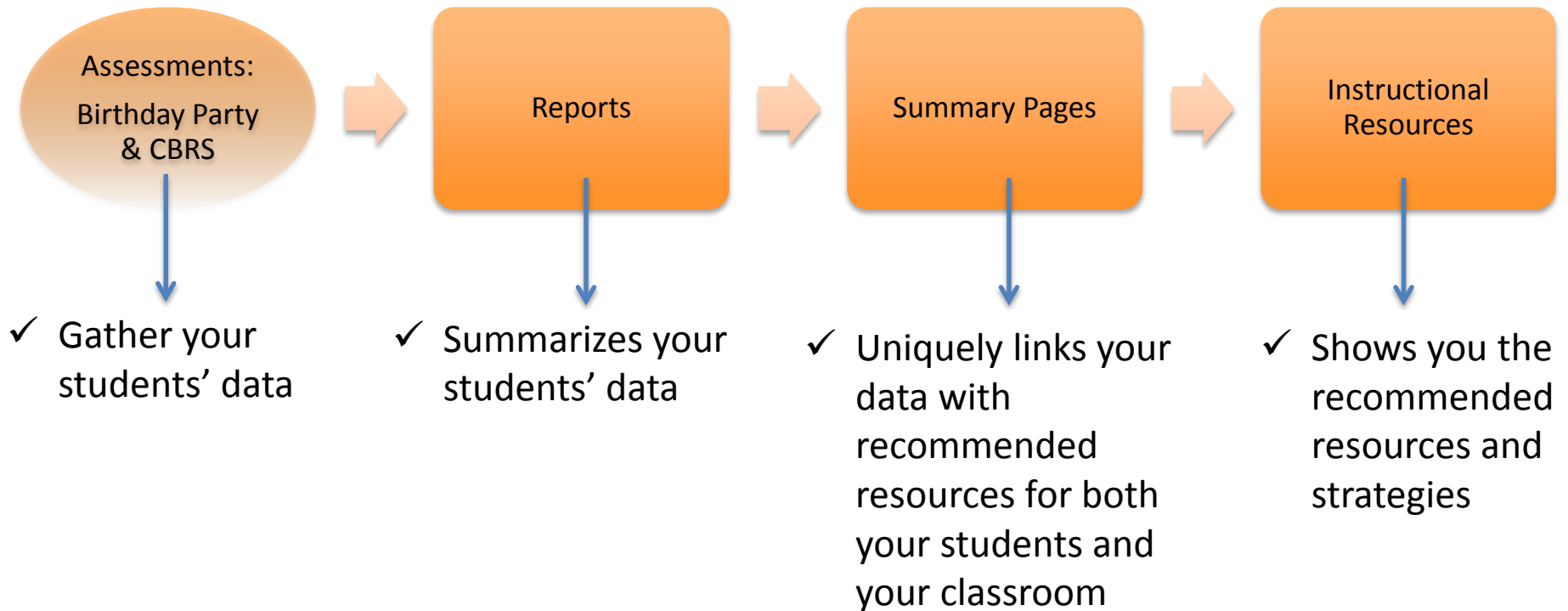


# Readiness Variability-Example Division 2

# Data Driven and Strategic Investments

- Develop preschool version of VKRP
- Gather pre & post data during kindergarten
- Track children longitudinally from K to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade
- Inform division leaders, city councils, policy makers and other stake holders to target interventions to improve outcomes using the data
- Target intervention dollars in early education and K – 3<sup>rd</sup> grade
