




## Our Mission

The mission of the Virginia Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity (SBSD) is to provide education and assistance; economic opportunity; and access to capital to generate employment and economic growth for small, women-owned, and minority-owned businesses.

We strive to accomplish this mission by offering businesses opportunities through business development, financing, business certifications, and access to contracting.



### Background

#### 2002 Disparity Study

• From 1998-2002, only 1.27 percent of state contracts were awarded to women-owned and minority-owned businesses.

#### 2009 Disparity Study

• For 2007, 2.82 percent of state contracts were awarded to women-owned and minority-owned businesses.

#### 2020 Disparity Study

• From July 2014 to June 2019, 13.3 percent of state contracts were awarded to women-owned and minority-owned businesses.


### **Certification Statistics**

### Commonwealth Expenditures



In FY23, the Commonwealth spent over \$2.9B with small, womenowned, and minorityowned businesses.

Of that \$2.9B, approximately \$537M (6.06%) was spent with women-owned businesses and \$600M (6.77%) was spent with minority-owned businesses.

# 2025 Disparity Study

In the 2024 General Assembly session, HB 716, which was incorporated into HB1404, requires SBSD to conduct a disparity study every five years, with the next study due no later than January 1, 2026.

# 2025 Disparity Study

The study shall:

- **Evaluate** the need for enhancement and remedial measures to address the disparity between the availability and the utilization of women businesses.
- **Recommend** measures that consist of narrowly tailored procurement policies to address • documented statistical disparities between the availability and utilization of women and minority -owned businesses.
- **Incorporate** the findings of past disparity studies conducted by Virginia and evaluate ٠ Virginia's progress toward the recommendations of those studies.
- **<u>Utilize</u>** the results of the disparity study and the recommendations therein to update a • statewide goal for SWaM business procurement and similar individual goals for women owned and minority -owned businesses for the purpose of closing any disparity demonstrated by such study.
